CORRIGENDUM

In view of enforcement of Model Code of Conduct post the declaration of General Elections by Election Commission of India, it has been decided that Admit Cards issue and other subsequent recruitment related works shall be kept in abeyance till completion of Model Code of Conduct. Candidates may however fill up forms online as per Advertisement No DITEC 36/2018/85 dated 7th March, 2019.
